Privacy Policy

1.0 Introduction & Scope

- 1.1 The nature of Intelling Group's business means that, on occasion, we'll require some personal details and some business details from our customers and website users. Special Category data maybe held upon request of our employees
- 1.2 The information you share with us, along with data on how you use our websites helps us to better understand our customers as a group and as individuals. This in turn helps us to provide a range of products and services that meet your needs.
- 1.3 This Privacy Policy will explain how the Intelling Group safeguards your information and how we use it to improve our products and services for the benefit of all our customers and website users. It also outlines how we use information for prospective employees.
- **1.4** The policy applies to Intelling staff and third party-suppliers.

2.0 What data do we collect?

- **2.1** Intelling Group collects the following data:
 - Personal identification information (name)
 - Other personal information (email, telephone number, work experience & role preferences)
 - Business information (company name, job title, number of employees, company email address and company contact telephone number)
 - Special category data (on some campaigns and for staff to make reasonable adjustments)

3.0 How do we collect your data?

- 3.1 You directly provide Intelling Group with most of the data we collect. We collect and process data when you:
 - Register online or place an order for any of our products or services
 - Voluntarily complete a customer survey or provide feedback on any of our message boards or via email
 - Voluntarily apply for a job
 - Use or view our website via your browser's cookies
 - Purchased from data suppliers
- **3.2** Intelling Group may also indirectly receive your data from the following sources:
 - Publicly available business information such as Companies House.



4.0 How will we use your data?

- **4.1** Intelling Group collects your data so that we can:
 - Process your order and manage your account
 - Email you with special offers on other products and services we think may be of interest
 - Process an application for vacancies advertised on our website
- **4.2** If you agree, Intelling Group will share your data with our partner companies so that they may offer you their products and services or potential employment. Our partner companies include:
 - Intelling Ltd
 - Switch Experts
 - WorkAir
- **4.4** When Intelling Group processes your information, it may send your data to, and also use the resulting information from, credit reference agencies to prevent fraudulent purchases or applications.

5.0 How do we store your data?

- **5.1** Intelling Group securely stores your data.
- 5.2 Intelling Group will keep your data as long as your business is a trading entity. Intelling Group verifies and validates the data accuracy by telephone and email. Businesses that are dissolved will be removed from the active business market file
- 5.3 We will hold all candidate data for a maximum of 12 months, at which point a review will take place to determine if the data should be retained for a further period or removed from the business. Permission is always obtained from the individual to retain their data. All data retention timeframes are recorded within a data map.

7.0 What are your data protection rights?

- 7.1 Intelling Group would like to make sure you are fully aware of all your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:
 - **The right to access** you have the right to request copies of your personal data from Intelling Group. We may charge a fee for this service.
 - The right to rectification You have the right to request that Intelling Group correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Intelling Group to complete the information you believe is incomplete.



- **The right to erasure** You have the right to request that Intelling Group erase your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to restrict processing** You have the right to request that Intelling Group restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- **The right to object to processing** You have the right to object to Intelling Group processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.
- The right to data portability You have the right to request that Intelling Group transfer the data that we have collected to another organisation, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

8.0 Cookies

- 8.1 Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behaviour information.
